#### **Isolation** (10 minutes)

## **Explanation** (10 minutes)

- The teacher writes and reviews the following on the white board:
  - o Gerund and infinitives can replace a noun in a sentence.
  - Gerund
    - A gerund is the present participle form of a verb "-ing" it acts as a
    - A gerund can be a subject, direct object or indirect object.
    - Examples
      - He stopped smoking.
      - I remember calling you.
      - I forgot buying that book.
  - o Infinitive
    - An infinitive is "to" + the base form of the verb.
      - Examples
        - He stopped to smoke.
        - o I must remember to call you.
        - I forgot to buy you a present.

#### Focused Practice (15 minutes)
